Articles of Incorporation

The undersigned natural person(s) of the age of eighteen years or more, a domestic or foreign corporation, a partnership or an association acting as incorporators under the Oregon Nonprofit Corporation Law, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I The name of this corporation is Portland Country Dance Community.

(The corporate Name cannot contain any word or phrase which indicates or implies that it is organized for any purpose other than one or more of the purposes contained in its articles of incorporation; and cannot contain the word "cooperative". See ORS 61.071.)

and its duration shall be perpetual unless limited _____

ARTICLE II The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:
That the corporation may engage in any lawful activity, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61. In addition, the primary purpose of the corporation is to promote the knowledge and encourage the practice of traditional country dance and music.

(It is not necessary to set forth in the articles any of the corporate powers enumerated in ORS 61.061. It is sufficient to state, either alone or with other purposes, "That the corporation may engage in any lawful activity, none of which is for profit, for which corporations may be organized under ORS Chapter 61"; however, it is desirable to state the primary purpose of the corporation in conjunction with such statement.)
